Muhammad Faris said the team was undergoing intensive training to prepare for the championship.

Each day, four hours is dedicated to training and enhancing their skills.

"We will be competing with 16 teams from the United States, Ireland, Germany, Japan, China and France.

"Despite the challenge, we will strive to achieve a podium position at the tournament," he added.
